STROLLS IN THE OLD MAUSSANE



The borough called « Vieux Maussane » is the historical heart of the village. Till 1754, when the building of the church was completed, it concentrated the majority of the habitants.

Have a walk around this borough, starting from Henri Giraud square (behind the school).

Go down to the avenue des
Marronniers and turn rightin
picturesque street rue du Vieux
Maussane which leads to the historical
heart of the village.

You will discover mansion-house called « Maison Quenin ».

This mansion-house was built just before the French Révolution.
Afterwards, Dr Denis Honoré QUENIN decided to bring his doctor's practice here.



In 1810 Dr Denis-Honoré QUENIN had a fountain and a small wash house built on a field of his mansion which he offered to the habitants.



This public fountain was a meeting point in the freshness of water flowing from the pipes, and is was also a source of interaction between washerwomen in the village.

Make a stop by "Planet", a small square which invites to daydreaming and may inspire you writing postal cards...



Take the opportunity to refresh at the **fountain** or at the nearby small **wash house.**



Go up to the street Charloun Rieu and stop by Jean Martin's shop.



Gourmands will find here Provençal cuisine workshops and lots of local products (olives, tapenades, pistou and many more)!

Go on further and you'll arrive to the OLIVE OL MILL Jean-Marie Cornille. It will welcome you in its vaulted rooms to visit "Le Grenier à olives" exposition and olive oil tastings.



Olive oil production and its different varieties will hold no secrets for you!

Go back down to the street Charloun Rieu and turn left to take « Chemin des Batignolles » path (a railway dating 1887) which will lead you back to Henri Giraud square.
