

RULES of the GAME

· In turn, each player mentally counts from 1 to 6 and the others stop him. The player who did the highest number starts playing by moving his pawn accordingly. Pawns can be made by what you find on-the-spot : little stones, twigs ...etc... Give your imagination free rein !

□ Who stands on a **SQUARE WITH A MAP OF FRANCE** must meet a challenge set by the other players within the allotted time.

□ Who stands on a **SQUARE WITH ?** Must answer the question on the square.

□ Who stands on a **SQUARE WITH A GOOSE**, replay the same scores.

□ Who stands on **SQUARE 03**, acquires new friends and go to square 70

□ Who stands on **SQUARE 67** waits till the Alsatian stork laid eggs and passes

□ Who stands on **SQUARE 10**, waked up at dawn and go directly to square case 21

· Who stands on **SQUARE 10**, s'est levé à l'AUBE et va directement à la case 21

· Who stands on **SQUARE 18**, will pay it dearly and passes twice

· Who stands on **SQUARE 25**, moves slowly to square 26

· Who stands on **SQUARE 34**, becomes a super hero and moves to square 96

· To win, you must stand right on square **96**. If a player scores too many points he must move back accordingly

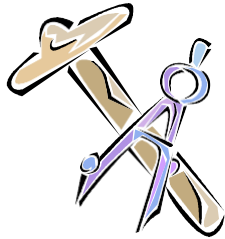
MAP of FRANCE of ashlar stonework

► Some History ...

This monument is unique in France. It pays homage to manual workers and notably to stone cutters. Their noble, skilled and hard job gave the prestige of our architectural inheritance.



This is a 5m x 5m and about 6 tonnes giant puzzle. It is made of as many stones as French departments. Stone cutters chose the most representative stone of their own area, cut and offered it.

Journeyman stone cutters engraved the 1400 characters, sculpted the blazons, and laid the edifice.

It is a collective work which required 7 years efforts. Author Bernard Souveton supervised more than 120 craftsmen, journeymen and apprentices of vocational training centers.

They all took part in the work voluntarily, just for the hell of it, with their intelligence and their hands, with their know-how and sweat and with their heart...



The dedication at the foot of the monument is an homage that quarrymen and stone cutters of today paid to those of yesterday. While building cathedrals and castles, chapels and modest houses, they built our common heritage : France...

This monument in free access, nowadays belongs to Municipality. People can find their department and catch a little taste of home wherever they come from France. Children can learn the name of french departments and locate them.

We propose you to discover this monument in family or with friends by playing Snakes and Ladders ! A funny way to make some history and geography.



Nothing is as simple as playing ! Go to Agora Alpilles park (a compulsory step to play). Thanks to this leaflet, some reflection and cleverness, you will have a great time !
